
Instructions for the tutor to read

Ensure students are sitting quietly. Be strict as the instructions are easy; they just require careful listening. Read it once only unless students are completely lost! It should all be a bit of fun anyway.

Instructions 1

Read the instructions to the students. Keep going, clearly and quickly.

a) Circle the animal. Do not write any letters.



b) Write your name on the line.

d) Answer each addition problem. Leave the subtraction problems blank.

e) Circle each type of fruit. Ignore the line between cherry and red.



Instructions 2

- 1) If there is a star circle it. Circle the moon if it is next to the star. Underline both the star and the moon unless they are shapes.
- 2) Circle the rectangle if it is between the two hearts. Cross out each shape unless any of them are ovals.
- 3) If an apple is a fruit circle it. If a car has wings circle it. If a shoe can be used for walking, circle it. Underline each picture unless it has a windshield.
- 4) Put an X on the bridge unless "bridge" starts with "b." Put an X on the cube unless it has 2 sides. Circle the 3 unless it is a number. Draw a box around the bird if it has wings.
- 5) Circle the country if it is next to the stop sign. Unless the ruler is between a stop sign and a calendar, cross it out. If the country is first, then underline the last picture.
