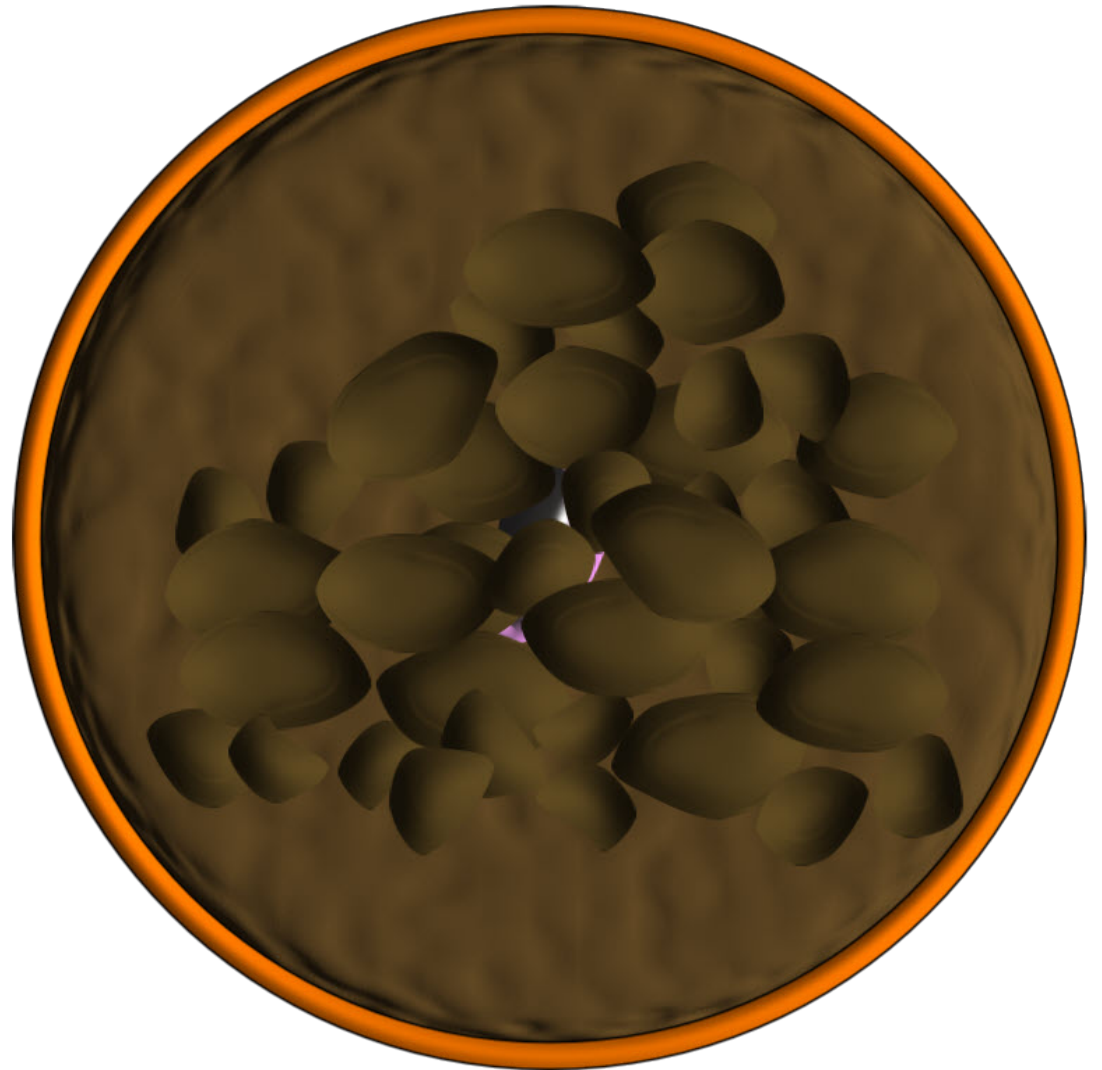
Place a seed

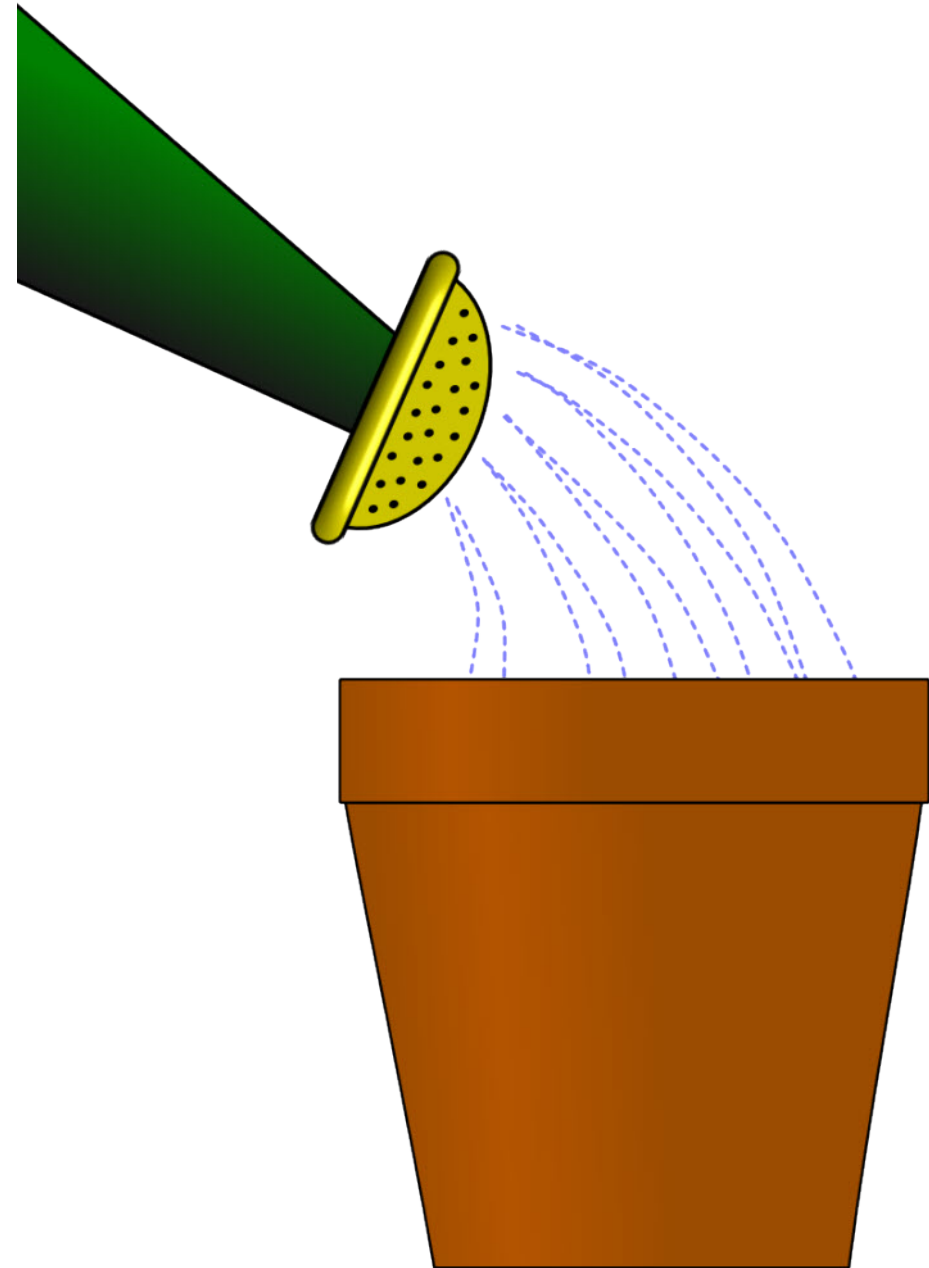
Cover the seed

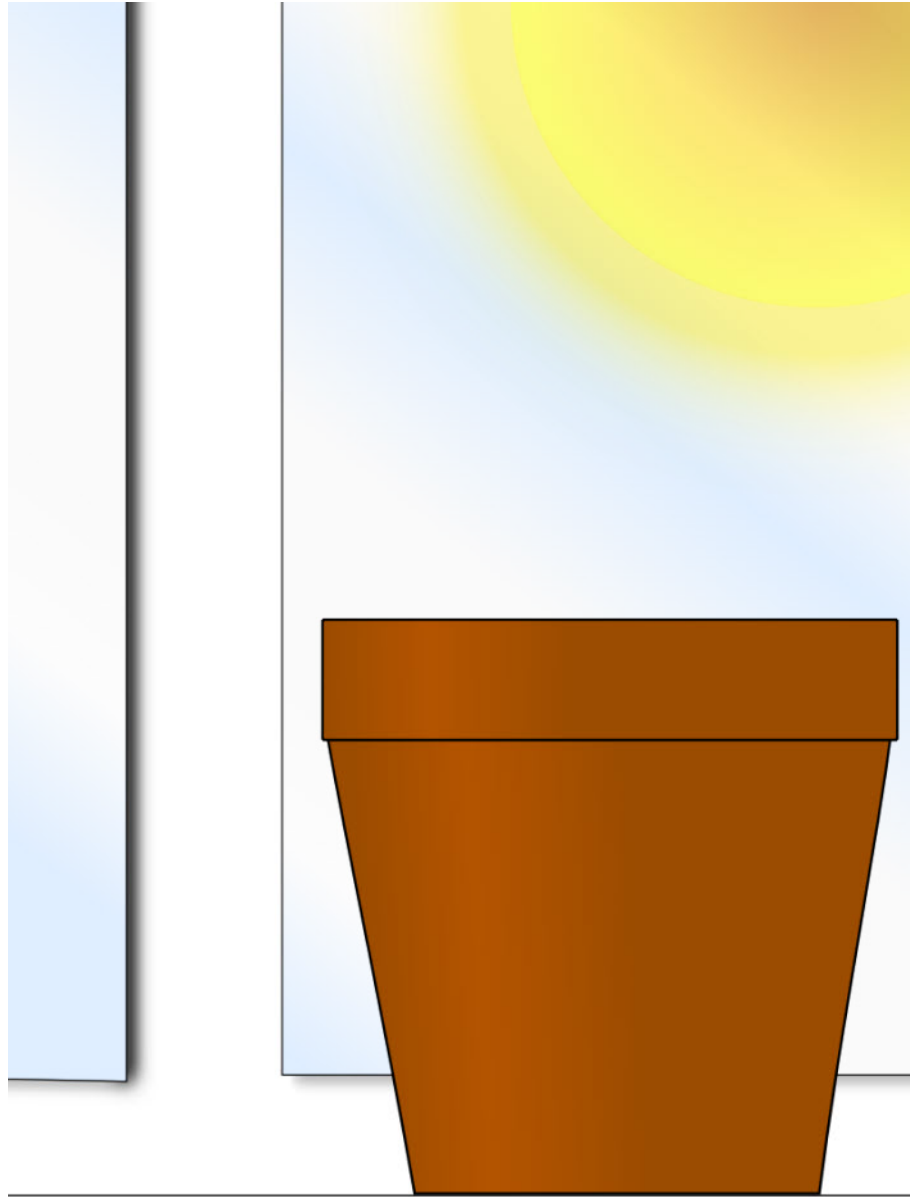
Dampen the soil.

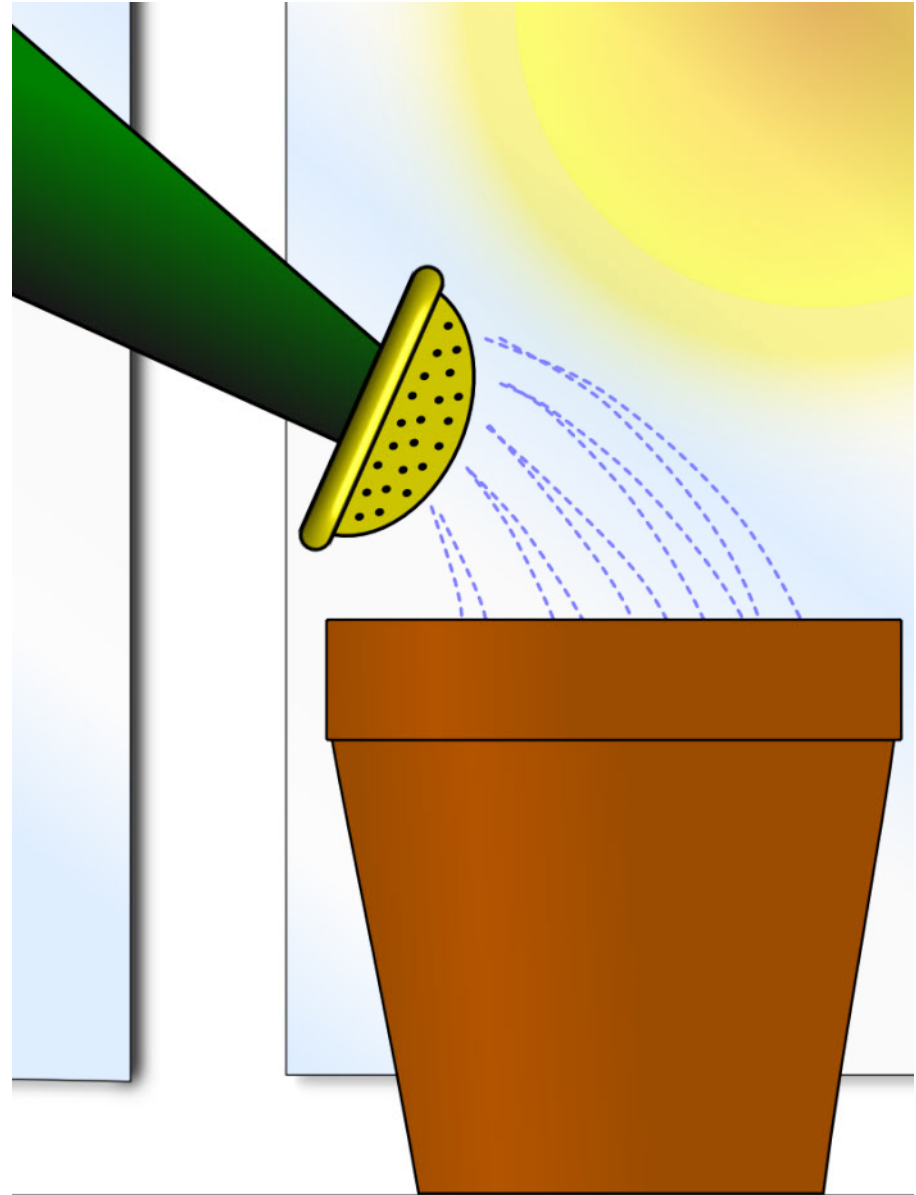

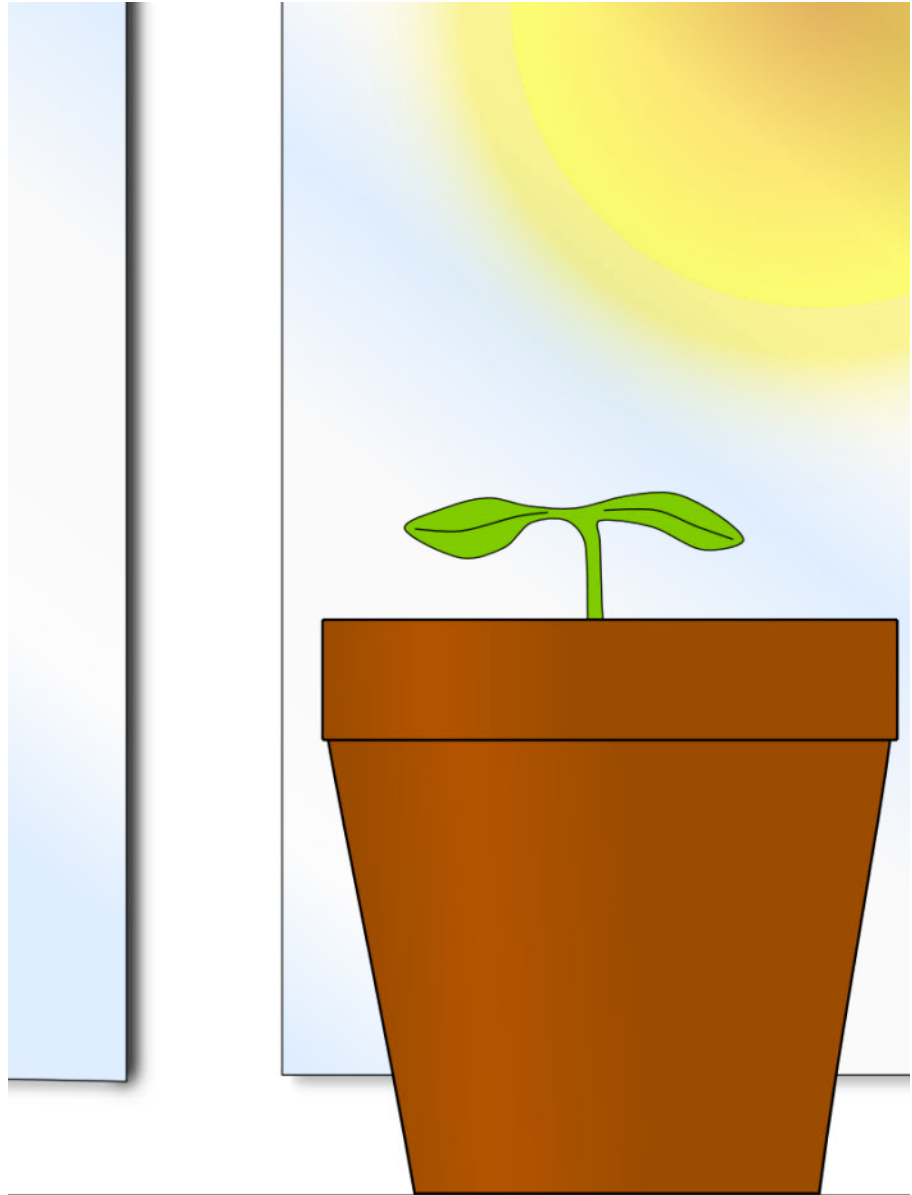

Water regularly.



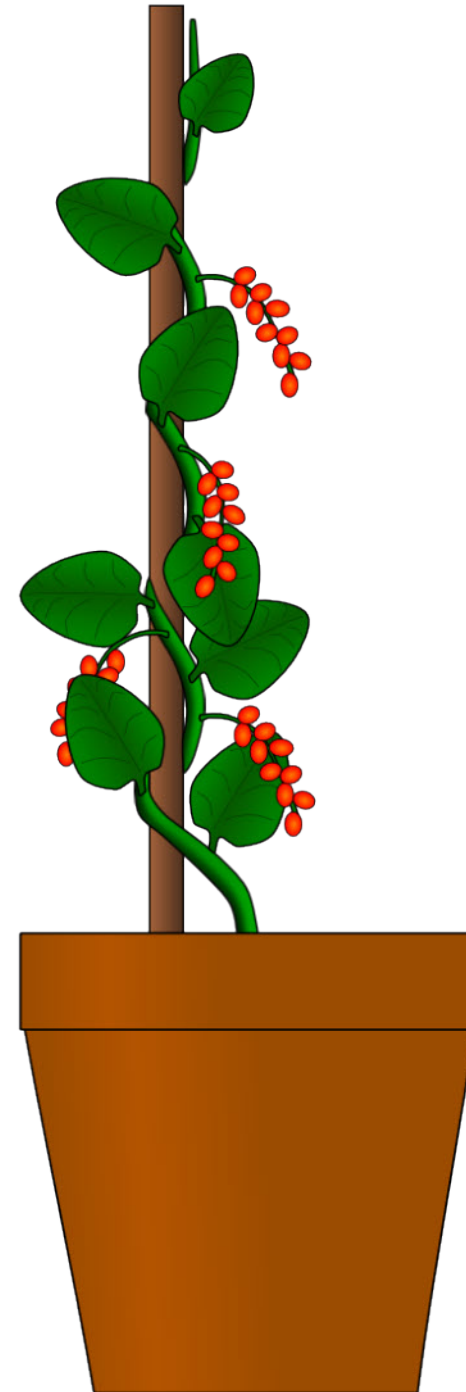
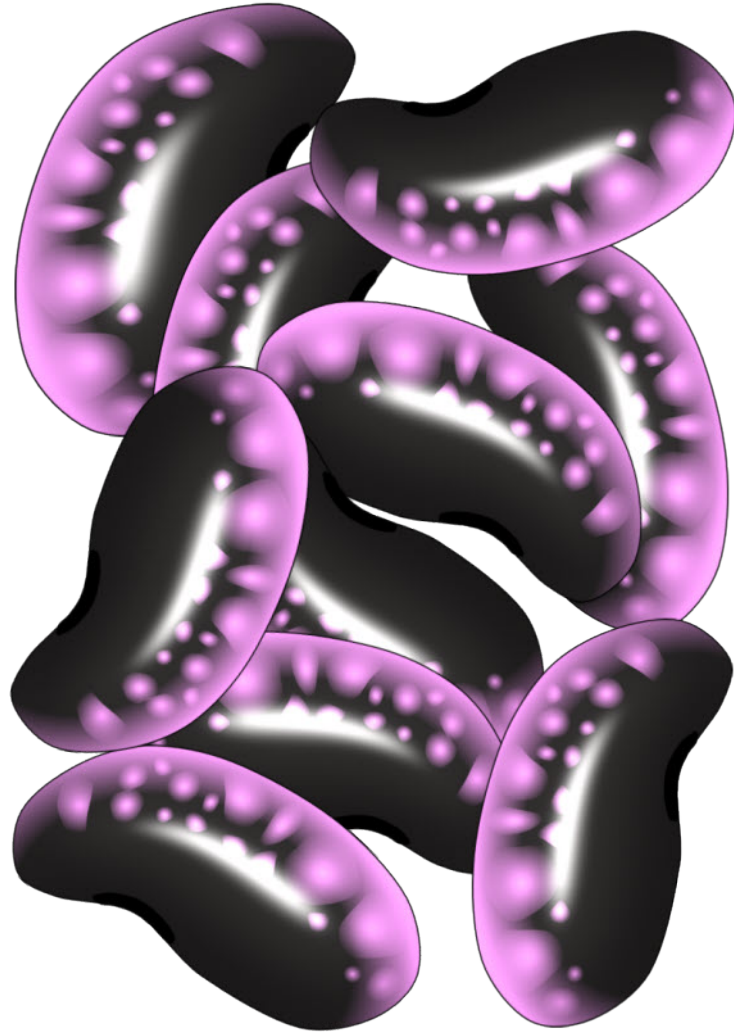
