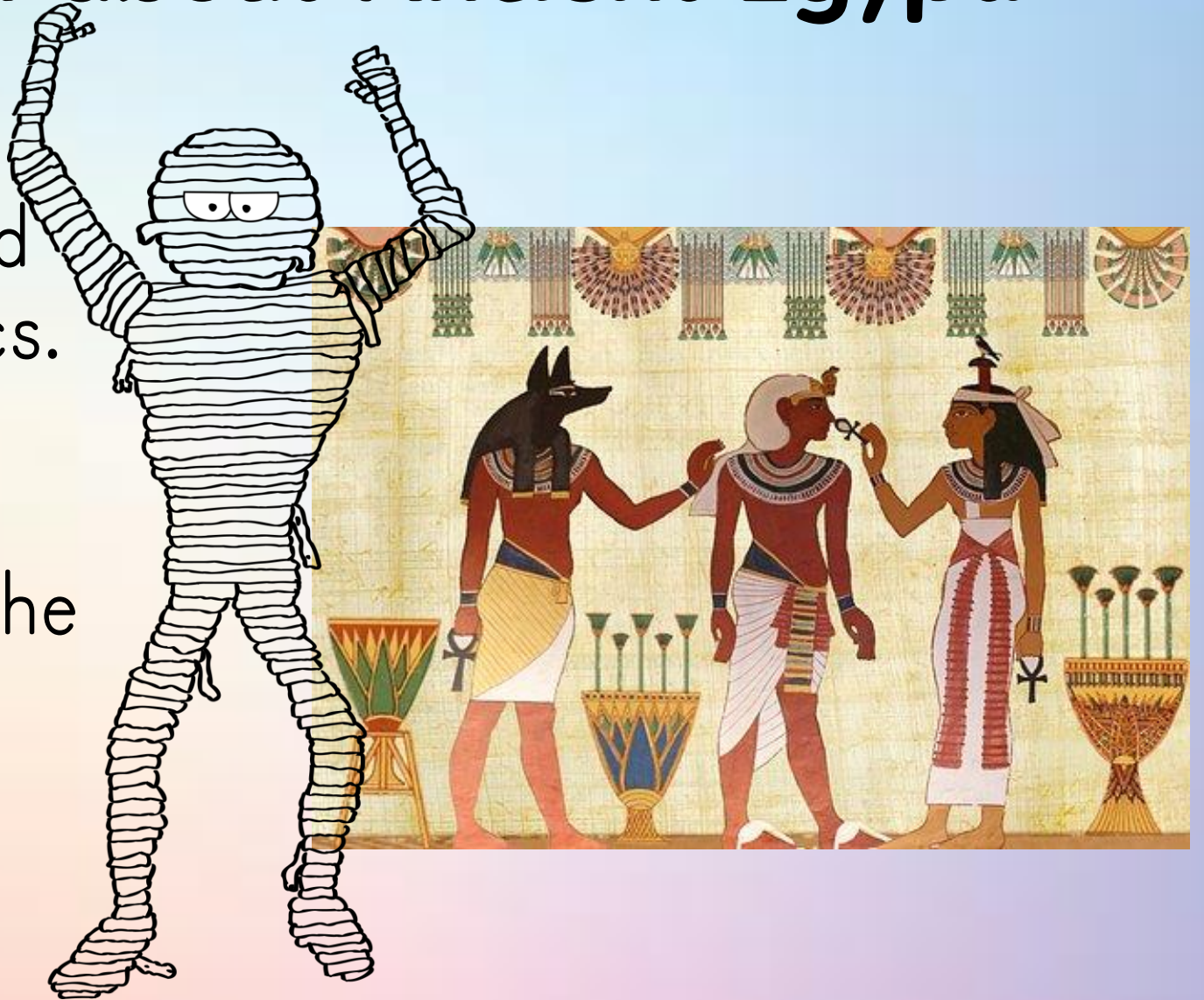

Q: Write information about Ancient Egypt.

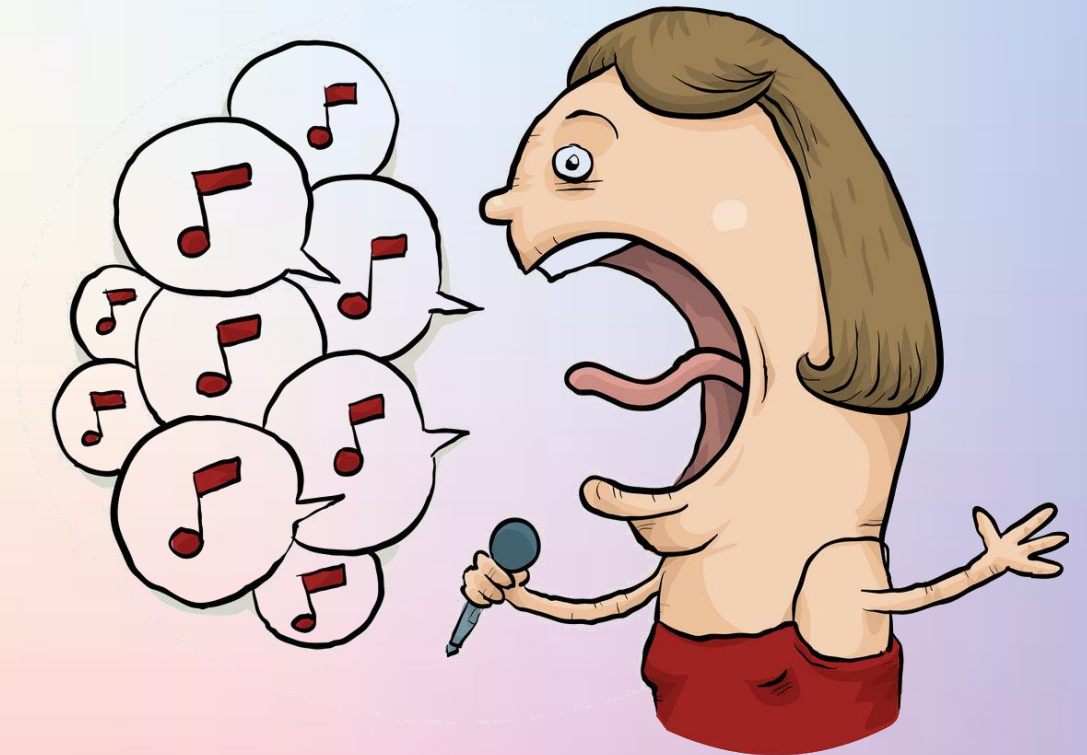

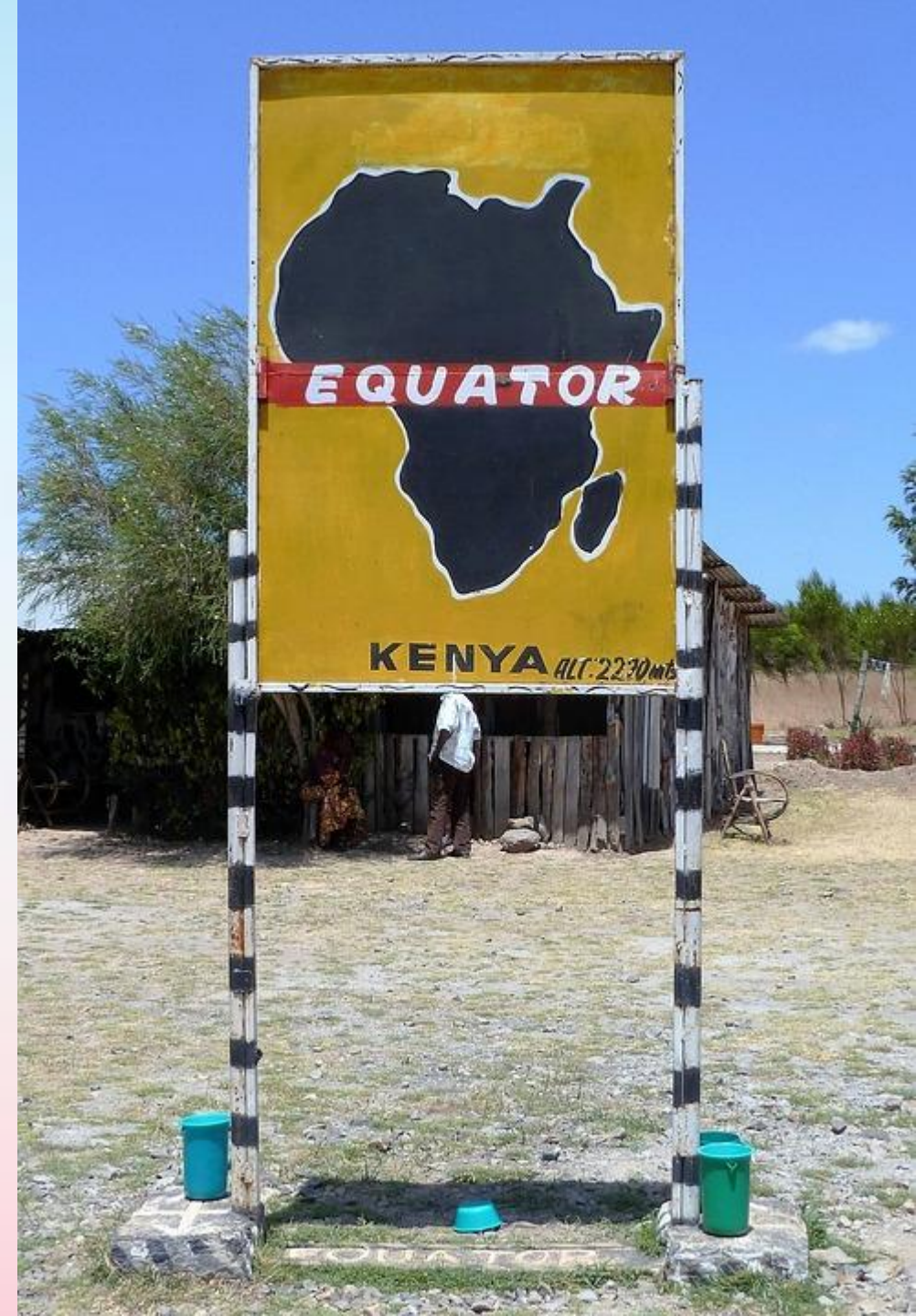
Q: Who was Socrates?
